Pizzerias are usually open from 11 A.M. to 3:30 or 4 P.M. and again from about 6 P.M. to midnight. Expect to pay 3–4 euros (\$3.80–\$5.10) for a simple pizza, up to 8 euros (\$10.20) for one with multiple ingredients.
